Curriculum - *Everyday Mathematics by the University of Chicago School*

Everyday Mathematics is the program used for the Math Replacement Program. The program includes all the district grade level math goals and challenges the student to develop a higher level of understanding of numbers.

File Folder System

The students will use an expandable file folder to organize their papers and books. Students are expected to keep their file folder organized. Please note that I will send home all tests for you to see, sign, and return the next day.

Absences

Students “pulled out” of class for other activities (this is mainly for band or orchestra students) are responsible for the lesson and work that is missed. If a student is missing class due to an in-school activity they are still expected to make-up all assignments and homework. It is best if a student pairs up with another classmate when they have missed class; due to limited class time I will not be able to re-teach the lesson.

Homework will typically be assigned approximately 2 – 3 nights a week and is due the next day unless otherwise noted. A study guide will be given one day before a test is scheduled.
