Dear LZHS Families,

District 95 believes that the iPad is a powerful tool for learning. It allows students to acquire important skills of communication and collaboration, to have access to a wide range of digital resources, and to persevere with challenging work. We also recognize the importance of teaching students appropriate use of the Internet, developing our students as digital citizens, and using the best possible security and filtering to keep students safe. As a District, we strive to make our physical school buildings as well as our virtual learning spaces safe for students. With this goal in mind, we will be implementing security enhancements recently released by Apple and Securely, our at home Internet filtering system, on all District issued student iPads.

These changes include an upgrade to the filtering system to require students to login as well as transitioning high school students to a new managed Apple ID created by Apple specifically for educational institutions. Details regarding both of these changes and implications for student use of the device at home and in the classroom are included in the attached PDF. **Please take some time over the next several days to familiarize yourself with the upcoming changes as well as the important dates.**

It is our intent that these enhancements will encourage students to focus on the iPad as a tool for learning and provide a continued safe virtual space for that learning.
