Art for 2nd Grade

Know the language of the arts.

The student will be able to...

Identify the elements of line, shape, space, color and texture; the principles of repetition and pattern; and the expressive qualities of mood, emotion and pictorial representation.

- Identify specific principles of art: pattern and repetition.
- Recognize primary and secondary colors.
- Label dimensions of 2-D and 3-D artworks.
- Identify ways in which various artists use elements and principles within their art.
- Identify mood or emotion shown in the artwork

Identify similarities in and among the arts (e.g., pattern, sequence and mood).

- Understand relationships between pattern and rhythm throughout the arts.

Through creating and performing, understand how works of art are produced.

The student will be able to...

Identify media and tools and how to use them in a safe and responsible manner when painting, drawing and constructing.

- Demonstrate eye/hand coordination when using tools and materials to create and artwork.

Demonstrate knowledge and skills to create visual works of art using manipulation, eye-hand coordination, building and imagination.

- Create artwork using various elements and principles of art.

Understand the role of the arts in civilizations, past and present.

The student will be able to...

Identify the distinctive roles of artists and audiences. Identify how the arts contribute to communication, celebrations, occupations and recreation.

- Explore a variety of artists and their artwork.
- Recognize how the arts are integrated into life through celebrations, occupations, communications and recreation.

Know how images, sounds and movement convey stories about people, places and times.
