



HALLOWEEN ACTIVITIES

Thursday, October 29

Creepy, wild activities will occur at Isaac Fox School on Thursday, October 29. The following information will help you prepare for that fun day.

ALL KINDERGARTEN STUDENTS SHOULD WEAR THEIR HALLOWEEN COSTUMES TO SCHOOL. If a mask is worn, this should be carried by the student to avoid any mishaps due to visibility issues.

First through fifth grade students are **not** to wear costumes to school, but should bring them in a bag. They will have time to change into their costumes after lunch.

The morning kindergarten parade will begin at 9:30 A.M. The kindergarten students will visit some of the classrooms and then parade around the front of the school at which point moms, dads, brothers, sisters, and any other family members are welcome to observe, take pictures, etc. After the parade, the room parents will provide the Halloween party in the classrooms. Although parents are invited to join us for the parade festivities, we ask that **ONLY** room parents be present during the room parties. This will help us avoid overcrowding and confusion in the classrooms.

- At about 1:00-1:10 students in grades 1-5 will don their costumes.
- At approximately 1:20 the parade for grades K-5 will begin. Students will exit the west doors by the flag pole, walk around the east side of Isaac Fox, and re-enter the building from the rear lobby doors (grades K-3) or the rear blue hall doors (grades 4-5).

If the weather permits and you live close by, please consider walking to school. Parking is extremely limited. Thanking you in advance.

Please note:

When selecting a costume for your child, please remember that it is often chilly and/or windy outside (especially around the school) at the end of October. Unless it is raining, we will conduct the parade outside. **Costumes that require accessories such as guns, swords, etc. are not allowed. We would also like to strongly discourage costumes that are highly gory.**

If the weather outside is particularly wet, we will conduct the afternoon parade in the gym. If that were to occur, parents are asked to go directly to the gym/cafeteria area and avoid congregating in the halls. We will then call the students to the gym by grade level, and they will parade across the stage area.
