BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Special Education data is statistically analyzed yearly to compare and contrast concrete information regarding student enrollment, special education programs, and personnel.

The date for the 2009-2010 school year reflects a similar pattern to the 2008-2009 school year with a slight decrease in the number of students that started the school year with an active IEP.

Enrollment data for students attending In-District and Out-of-District Special Education Programs is provided as well as relevant comparisons of District 95, State, and National percentages of special education populations. At this time, there are no significant changes in student placements for the 2009-2010 school year.

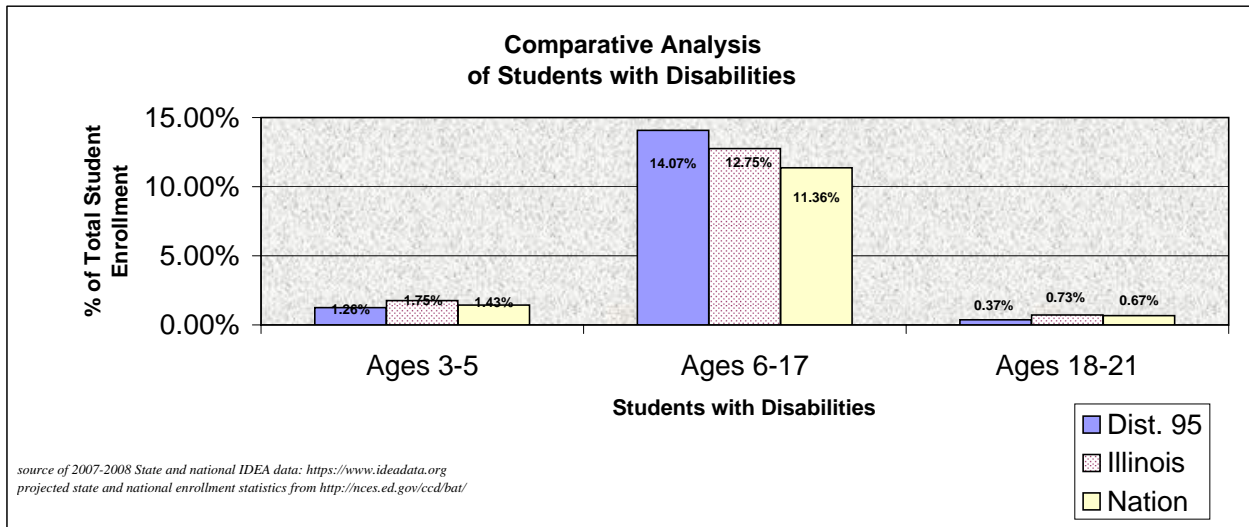
