COURSE AND CLASSROOM EXPECTATIONS

HOMEWORK

- Expect to have homework each night. Completion is important to your success!
- Assignments will be collected and/or checked daily. They should be thorough and **IN PENCIL**. (Work done in **ink** will **not** be accepted for credit.)
- Homework can be turned in for PARTIAL CREDIT up until the test day for that chapter.

NOTES/BOOK

- You should keep an organized, dated record of each day's notes. It is expected that you will take notes when information is presented.
- A 3-ring binder will be most appropriate to keep yourself organized.
- You are responsible for obtaining notes for any day for which you are absent.
- You will be assigned a book. You need to bring your book to class every day. You are responsible for keeping the book in its current condition. At the end of the year you must hand in the book you were assigned or pay for a replacement.

QUIZZES/TESTS

- Expect chapter tests at the end of each chapter. These may include multiple choice, show-your-work, review, vocabulary, matching and bonus problems.
- The day prior to a test will be review.
- If you are absent on the day of the test, you need to arrange a time with me to make it up. This can be done in the math resource center (room C117) or your Academic Skills class.
- There will be some opportunities for test corrections to be made for partial credit.
- Expect quizzes to occur two to three times per chapter, usually announced ahead of time.

GRADING SCALE
