

**Circle Map with Frame of Reference -
for defining in context.**

"Tell me everything you know about pollution and how you know these things. What experiences have you had that taught you about pollution?"

Tree Map - for classifying/grouping.

"Take a position on a topic and classify your main reasons for that position. Be sure to include specific details and examples to support each of your reasons."

**Bubble Map -
for describing with adjectives.**

"Use vivid language to describe the characters in the story. Be sure to include not only words the author uses but descriptors you can infer from the story as well."

**Double Bubble Map -
for comparing and contrasting.**

"Examine the similarities and differences between these two geometric figures."

**Flow Map -
for sequencing and ordering.**

"Explain in writing the steps you followed to solve this problem."

**Multi-Flow Map -
for analyzing causes and effects.**

"Discuss what might cause tooth decay and tell some of the effects of poor dental hygiene."

**Brace Map -
for identifying part/whole relationships.**

"Analyze the structure of the computer to determine its parts and subparts."

Bridge Map - for seeing analogies.

"Choose two historical leaders and show their relationship to important movements or conflicts. Remember to state your relating factor."
