My "Be" Expectations

Classroom Expectations

- Wait outside the classroom if I am not present.

Supplies

- Must be written in complete sentences and "No Excuse Words" apply.
- If you lost your assignment and need a copy, check the extra bin box or online.

- All homework assignments are worth 6 points. It must be completed and done well.
- Half credit, 3 points, will be given for assignments that are half completed with effort or for late assignments that are completed the next day.
- If you have a late work you will receive an Academic Accountability for 1st and 2nd quarters.

Laboratory Work and Projects

- Follow the rubric for lab reports and quarter challenges.
- Lab reports and quarter challenges should be typed or written neatly in pen.
- All pictures, charts, graphs should be done in colored pencils, NO markers or crayons.
