As a family, briefly summarize one experience that demonstrates the character trait of the month and return it to your child's teacher during the first week of that month. Sharing family examples of character with their peers will help the children to broaden their understanding of the many ways the character traits are played out every day in all areas of life.

A "Families for Character Tree" will also be established in the building as a place to display a variety of our family assignments each month.
