### Going Green in January 2010!

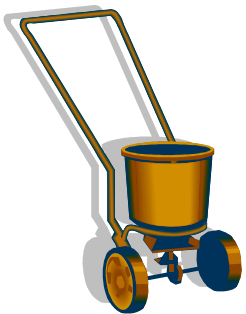
In anticipation of this District wide endeavor, soon we will be requesting email addresses from all parents/guardians for whom we do not already have one. We will greatly appreciate your help!

## General Notification of Applications of Fertilizer, Herbicides or Pesticides
