St. Vincent de Paul Food Pantry

Located in St. Francis de Sales Ministry Center
135 S. Buesching Road, Lake Zurich, IL

How It Works:

- The Pantry is open every Thursday from 6:00 – 8:00 p.m.
- The first time you come bring a photo ID and one document showing you live in Lake County (for example: electric bill, driver's license, gas bill).
- You will receive a pantry card that you will use each time you come to the pantry.
- A lottery system is used to determine entry into the pantry. When your number is called, you can walk through the pantry and shop for select items.

What's Available:

- Fresh fruit, vegetables, bread, and meat
- Breakfast cereal, peanut butter, rice, pasta, crackers
- Canned fruits, vegetables, soups, condiments
- Milk and eggs (on the first Thursday of the month)

Special Notes:

- If more than one family lives at the same address, both families can get their own pantry card and receive food.
- If you are not available on Thursday nights arrangements can be made so that you can receive food.



Alpine Chapel Food Pantry

Echo Lake/Miller Road, Lake Zurich

How It Works:

- The food pantry is open every Saturday from 9 a.m. - 12 p.m.
- Please bring a photo ID.

What's Available?

- Non-perishables, produce, meat, and non-food items.



The Chapel Mobile Food Pantry

How It Works:

- The Mobile Food Pantry is open to Lake County families. Registration is at the event (name, address, number of people in household, no proof of need required).
- The Mobile Food Pantry occurs about every 3 months.
- The next Mobile Food Pantries will be held on, November 3rd, January 19th, March 9th and May 25th from 10:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.

What's Available?

- A hot meal in the auditorium and 10-14 days of food (meat, produce, snacks, bread, etc.) per family. Up to 300 families are served per event.

Special Notes:

Emmaus House Community Dinner
