Kindergarten & 1st Graders

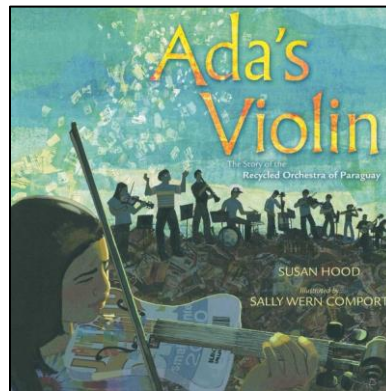
*After the Fall:

2nd & 3rd Graders

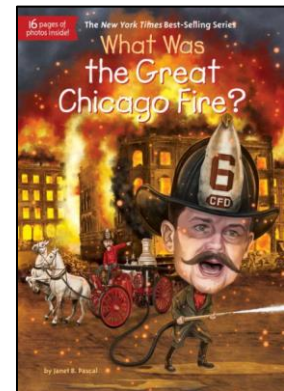
*Ada's Violin:
